St. Catherine University is a comprehensive university enrolling approximately 5,200 students at all degree levels, and distinguished by its baccalaureate college for women.

St. Catherine University received its first Extramural Associates Research Development Award in 2000.



Recognizing that faculty at teaching intensive institutions may have limited prior experience in grant-seeking and research, the Office of Research & Sponsored Programs (ORSP) has adopted a **professional development model** to provide leadership, education and mentoring to faculty in five interrelated areas: **Grant Seeking and Management; Research Design and Methodology; Research Ethics; Evaluation; and Writing, Publication and Dissemination.**

In addition, ORSP is charged with handling all pre- and post-award processes, ensuring compliance with regulations, developing institutional policies and procedures relating to grants and research and facilitating collaborations both internally and externally that build capacity in research and grant-seeking.

From June 2002 – May 2009, ORSP submitted 65 applications for government grants and subcontracts, 39 of which were funded for a total of \$5,632,790 in awards.
