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# American Indian/Alaska Native Population

- \* In U.S. ~ 4.1 million Al/AN (approx. 2% of U.S. pop.)
- In U.S. ~ 565 federally recognized tribes
- In U.S. ~ 328 Al reservations and land trusts
- In NM ~ 22 tribes with approx. 250 from other tribes residing in the state
- Across U.S. ~ 17 states do not have a federally recognized tribe in their state.

# American Indian/Alaska Native Population

- Approx. 870,000 Al/ANs reside in rural counties (Probst, Moore, Glover & Samuels, 2004).
- Although tribal groups may live in close proximity to one another:
  - differences among tribes
  - differences among members of the same tribe (Wittig, 2004)

### Health Disparities

- Indian life expectancy (72.6 years) is 5.2 years < that for US all races population</p>
- Tuberculosis (500% higher)
- Alcoholism (514% higher)
- Diabetes (177% higher)
- Unintentional injuries (140% higher)
- Homicide (92% higher)
- Suicide (82% higher) (I.H.S., 2011)
- Youth Suicide Native American/Alaskan Native and Hispanic youth have the highest rates of suicide-related fatalities.(CDC, 2009)
